**We work in partnership with the Northern Ireland Ambulance Service (NIAS) to provide the Helicopter Emergency Medical Service (HEMS) for N.I.**



**Our crew attend some of the most traumatic incidents across N.I. delivering the very best pre-hospital care to patients both at the scene & while transferring them to hospital.**



**On average, every single day at least one person in Northern Ireland finds themselves in desperate need of Air Ambulance NI.**



**Air Ambulance NI is a charity. Each day fundraising of £5,500 needs to be raised to keep our service operational. We rely on support from the public and local businesses.**

- Our paramedics undergo specialist technical crew member training.




## Doctors


- We have fifteen HEMS doctors.

- Every doctor in our crew, continues to work in their chosen hospital, alongside their shifts at the Helicopter Emergency Medical Service.







## Instructions


- Wash out and old jam jar (any jar or tub will do!)


